



Summer Program 2023

The Summer Camp Program is focused on school-age students ages 5 to 9 years old, Greens (age 5), Yellows (age 6 – 7), Blues (age 8 – 9)

Preschool, red group (ages 3 -4), will not be required to sign a summer application as they will not be participating in field trips other than a field trip to Draper Park, but they will be following the same program and any activities that will be held at Discovery Kids Center.

Each camp focuses on a different theme with a variety of activities that stimulate creativity and discovery of self and the world around them.

Daily activities include science, music, drama, exploration, arts and crafts, dance and movement, global awareness, history, literature, and character development.

A healthy snack is included during mid-morning and mid/afternoon. Children enrolled in full-day camps need to bring a backpack and a home lunch. When field trips do occur, please bring cold lunch.

WEEKLY COST:

- Full-day camps cost \$190.00 for 5-year-olds
- Half-day camps (Half Day or 3 days a week) cost 5-year-olds \$172.50
- Full-day camps cost \$170.00 for children 6 to 9 years old
- Half-day camps (Half Day or 3 days a week) cost \$157.50 for children 6 to 9 years old

<p>JUNE 19TH to JUNE 23RD</p>	<p>Snails & Trails (<i>Science: Geology</i>) All children will learn about the earth, tectonic plates, and volcanoes!</p> <p>5 to 9-Year-Olds will take a field trip to Little Beakers in Sandy Utah to learn and create a science experiment!</p>
<p>JUNE 26TH to JUNE 30TH</p>	<p>Snails & Trails (<i>Science: Geology</i>) All children will learn about different types of rocks and minerals.</p> <p>6- to 9-year-olds will get a chance to discover and identify their rocks after a hike!</p>
<p>JULY 3RD to JULY 7TH</p>	<p>America the Beautiful (<i>History & Literature</i>) Starts with a 4th of July student and family BBQ and Parade! All families are welcome to come to join DK's BBQ on July 3rd before the 4th of July. The children will learn about why we celebrate Independence Day and how each other celebrates with their family traditions.</p>
<p>JULY 10TH to JULY 14TH</p>	<p>Art Smart! (<i>Art History & Crafts</i>) Children will learn about famous artists and their different styles as well as painting like them.</p> <p>5- to 9-year-olds will take a field trip to the Museum of Fine Arts and "learn how to look at art".</p>



JULY 17TH to JULY 21ST

Where in the World is Sammy? (*Culture & Geography*)

Learn about who Sammy Seamonster is (our mascot). Explore different countries, cultures, and food! Each student will present their "All About My Family" or "All About Me" and parents are welcome to help their child do their presentation. Parents are also welcome to bring in food that's part of the student's family tradition! One of our teachers will bring a traditional Mexican snack!

5- to 9-year-olds will take a field trip to the Natural History Museum of Utah to visit the Native Voices and First People exhibit.

JULY 23RD to JULY 28TH

Under the Sea (*Science: Marine Biology*)

Children will learn and understand the characteristics of the ocean and marine life. Why coral reefs are important to the environment.

5- to 9-year-olds will take a field trip to the Loveland Living Planet Aquarium Guided tour.

JULY 31ST to AUGUST 4TH

Flix for Kids! (*Drama, Music & Movement*)

Children will learn about silent films, the Phi Phenomenon, First movies in color! And how to act without sound!
